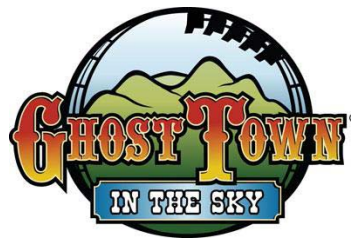

GHOST TOWN CASTING CALL SCHEDULED GHOST TOWN MUSIC HALL TO REOPEN – MUSICIANS SOUGHT

March 30, Maggie Valley – The complete renovation and restoration of the Ghost Town Music Hall is nearing concluded. The building, which had not been available for shows during the 2007 park season, will this year feature a complete kitchen for a full dining experience.

Guests will have the opportunity to enjoy a range of food offerings from a country hot lunch to lighter meals. Tables and counters will be available for visitors to relax with a meal and enjoy the variety of scheduled entertainment.

According to John Buccafusco, Director of Entertainment for Ghost Town, “Each day will feature a different entertainment theme. Everything from country and gospel groups, magic, comedy, sing-along events and cabaret shows will be offered.”

The line-up of entertainers who will perform at the Ghost Town Music Hall will include the Blackwoods, the Chuckwagon Gang, the Stamps Quartet, the Larkins and Sonoma Road.

“We would like to invite local musicians, musical groups and variety performers to become a part of the entertainment roster for the new Music Hall,” added Buccafusco. Auditions for these spots will be held on March 30 beginning at 11:00 am, at the Ghost Town Welcome Center on Soco Road (the A-frame building in Ghost Town’s Parking lot). Performers can contact Ghost Town for a scheduled showcase spot, 828-926-1140 x 316.

Entertainers should be prepared for a five-minute performance with musical equipment. Amplification should be minimal. CD or DVD and promotional package should be available.

April 4 & April 5, Maggie Valley – Auditions for western actors (male and female), singers, dancers and other performers will be held on Friday, April 4 and Saturday, April 5 at Ghost Town’s Welcome Center on Soco Road (the A-frame building in Ghost Town’s Parking lot). Call-backs will take place on Sunday, April 6. Auditions for musicians, musical groups and variety acts will be held on Sunday, March 30.

The audition schedule is as follows:

March 30

11:00 am

Musicians, Musical Groups, Variety Acts

Entertainers should be prepared for a five-minute performance with musical equipment. Amplification should be minimal. CD or DVD and promotional package should be available.

April 4

10:00 am

Singers/Dancers

Dancers should be prepared to learn a 1-minute routine.

Singers should bring sheet music with 16 bars or a CD with 1 minute track.

Singers and Dancers need to bring a head shot and data sheet if available.

3:00 pm

Western Actors

Western Actors should bring head shot and data sheet and are encouraged to wear clothing appropriate for fall onto gravel street

April 5

10:00 am – Western Actors

3:00 pm – Singers/Dancers

April 6

11:00 am – Call-backs for actors, singers and dancers.

John “JB” Buccafusco, Ghost Town’s Director of Entertainment, will be conducting the auditions. Saloon shows for the 2007 season were written by Buccafusco and Gunfights were written and staged by the Director, along with Robert Bradley, Gunfight Coordinator. Bradley began his acting career at the age of 16 during the early days of Ghost Town. He currently appears in the full length motion picture, “Ghost Town – The Movie”.

Buccafusco has an extensive background which includes holding the position of Entertainment Manager for Carnival Cruise Lines. Auditions for singers, dancers and western actors will be held during the weekend of April 4 and 5. Information can be obtained by contacting Ghost Town in the Sky at (828) 926-1140.
