TWO FILMS BEING SHOT AT GHOST TOWN THIS WEEKEND

Maggie Valley, NC – The wild-west theme park located on top of Buck Mountain in the heart of the Blue Ridge Mountains has been the choice for several film shoots lately. Ghost Town In The Sky will be the site for two film productions this weekend.

A national reality series on hunting will be filming their opening and closing scenes at Ghost Town, which will be used for every episode in the hunting series. The filming will take place on Ghost Town's Main Street, which is famous for its wild-west staged gunfights.

Will Bernardo, an Eastern North Carolina resident, and his production crew will be producing a short film for awards submission into this year's Asheville Film Festival, and they will be shooting footage at Ghost Town. The film is based on the true story of Frankie Silver, the first woman ever hanged in North Carolina, called "Finding Silver." Silver killed her husband in 1838 by pushing him into a lit fireplace and was later found guilty and hanged.

Dean Teaster's Ghost Town The Movie was also filmed at Ghost Town in the Sky in November, 2006. This movie was released into the rental market on video on October 28, 2008. Upon release, the film immediately became the #1 rented western movie of all time for 7 weeks in a row. It also ranked #11 in overall movies rented during its first week of release across the board.

"Ghost Town makes a nice backdrop for all sorts of films," explains Teaster. "Not only did shooting there make sense for my movie, but I can see why other producers would want to shoot footage from a place with such spectacular views, and Ghost Town's Main Street has 19th century replica buildings which depicts exactly what a western town was like in the mid to late 1800's."

Ghost Town in the Sky is a Western North Carolina landmark that will re-open for the 2009 season on May 22, 2009. The mile-high, theme park boasts live-action shows, rides for all ages, music and shopping. More information can be found by visiting <http://www.ghosttowninthesky.com>.
